1. Who I'm called to love

Names, not categories. If you get past five, ask God which ones are actually yours to carry this season.

2. Who I'm called to become

Two or three words. The character, not the accomplishments.

3. Who I'm called to serve

Categories, not names. With the gifts God actually gave you, what kind of people? One or two, not ten.

4. My sentence

"I'm called to love _____, to become _____, and to serve _____." Three callings side by side, one life. It will feel too small. Good.

5. One brick, in the next seven days

One thing that serves the sentence. Small enough that you cannot fail at it. Put a day on it.

6. One no, this week

One thing already on your plate that is not in your sentence.

This is a season sentence, not a life sentence. You are allowed to revise it with God, and you should.

Naming the target is as far as an audio can take you. The vision underneath it, the one where you know who you're becoming while you aim, tends to come slowly and with someone sitting alongside you. If you get to the end of praying about this and know there's more here than a sentence on a page, that's what the conversation is for.
